The transfer of the project innovation and event to ensure sustainability

The Social Integration State Agency (SISA) and EY Latvia for the first time organized the Baltic Sea Region Conference "Professional Rehabilitation for People with Disabilities. Strategic Direction" to discuss opportunities of vocational rehabilitation development in Europe. At the Conference there spoke experts from Estonia, Lithuania, Germany, Norway and Latvia making acquainted with the vocational rehabilitation management, tendencies and developments, as well as presenting practical examples of integration of persons with disabilities into the labour market.

Within the framework of the Conference the members of the project workgroup Indra Urdziņa-Merca and Santa Kundziņa together with pupils of Jurmala Secondary School of Vocational Education presented the learnt within FORCAVI project and demonstrated the "Life Quality" dimension. The aim was to give a brief insight into the achieved within the framework of the project and demonstrate innovation - the fact that people with intellectual disabilities are able to train others, as well as to discuss the quality of life and its dimensions. In the demonstration of the project idea there participated a student of the Social Integration State Agency Andris Šnepsts, who learned the educational program "Housekeeping", with the qualification of "Laundry Washer and Ironer" and six 'students of the educational program "Electronics and Electrical Engineering". When presenting the project there were used the presentation slides in the module of the "Life Quality" developed by the leading partner from Spain AFANIAS, as well as the offered by AFANIAS grouping of the quality of life in dimensions, using the "Flip chart" whiteboard.
